## \*Submitted Assignments:

- ✓ Check ProgressBook for grade
- ✓ The notes in the Comments section are the items you need to correct
- ✓ Make the necessary corrections
- ✓ Change the title in the header
  - o Add a 2 after the title
  - o Save As with a 2 at the end of the filename
- ✓ Submit the corrected copy

As work is returned to you, if you are unclear what your errors are or if you need assistance in correcting them, be sure to ask. Make the most of your opportunity to complete quality work.
