

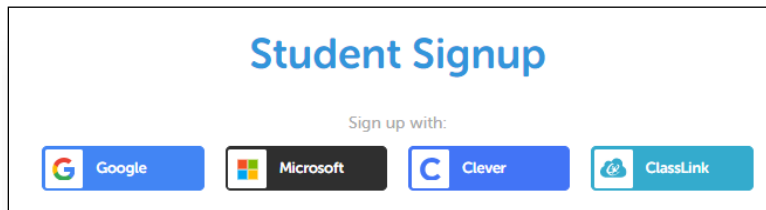

## Creating a Student Account

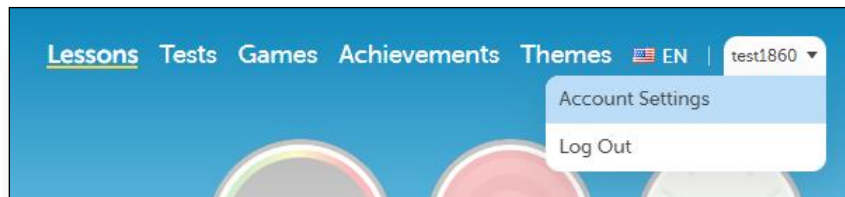
1. Go to [www.typing.com](http://www.typing.com)
2. At the top of the screen, hover over Sign Up Now and choose **Student Signup**



3. Sign up with Google
